

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**Foreword:**

This 4x4 Slovenia book is from our 4x4 Adventure Europe series. These books always describe a multi-day tour through a region / country. It is about daily stages where the off-road routes are integrated. On the one hand you can drive the region or the country by means of our day stages. All off-road routes are also described individually and can be used for your own planning and driven off.

**Daily stages:**

The daily stages are a mix of tar and offroad, we have tried to adapt the stage length to the offroad portion or to the sights. At the end of each day's stage, we have suggested places to stay, which can be guesthouses/hotels or campsites.

**Driving a day stage:**

Each day stage has a route description that you follow. At some point you will meet the beginning of an off-road route. In the daily stage is then indicated on which side one finds the description of the offroad distance. If one has driven the offroad distance then one jumps back again to the description of way of the daily stage.


**Single offroad distances:**

We have broken down the individual off-road routes in the book with map sketches. This has the advantage that you can drive each off-road route independently of daily stages. For each offroad route there is an entry point (green) and an exit point (red).

**4x4 Europe Marathon Master:**

On each offroad route there is at least one marathon place Who wants to participate in our marathon can drive the offroad routes without time limit and collect marathon points.





### Explanation of difficulty levels SG 1-5

**SG5:** All-wheel drive necessary with reduction -> very steep (washed out/gravelled) -> very steep incline/descent

**SG4:** All-wheel drive necessary -> heavy (washed out/gravelled) -> greater incline/descent

**SG3:** Without all-wheel drive -> washed out/gravelled -> greater gradient

**SG2:** Without all-wheel drive -> washed out/gravel-> hardly any incline

**SG1:** Smooth track without tar surface -> hardly any potholes



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## Day Stage 1 (What to expect today)

Get a taste of Slovenia and get your first impression of the nature of the routes in Slovenia.

The day's stage leads along the edge of a national park and wanders through touristy places. Bovec is known among outdoor fans for canyoning and rafting and the town of Kobarid is a permanent address for paragliders. The eye-catcher in Tolmin is the picturesque river valley where you can look down on the shimmering emerald-green Soca.

This day's stage impresses with 3 off-road routes: 4SL1 "Stol" (world-famous for its jump for paragliders); 4SL2 "gondola slope" and the 4SL3 "forest slope". Worth seeing: the Tolminer Gorge (hike and time required at least 2 hours)

If you love the hustle and bustle and are traveling in high season, the shore of Lake Bohinska Jezero is the right place for you (huge campsite with a lot of restaurants and cafes).

### Start of daily stage 1

**1** The starting point of the journey is at the **Predil Pass** (height 1156m + border I/Slo). Follow the winding road into the valley towards Bovec.

Bypass the town of Bovec towards Kobarid until you reach the town of Zaga.

From the junction you drive 5.2 km to the start of the 4SL1 (a junction to the left).



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### 4SL1 Tour summary

A fantastically beautiful route that is closed to motorcyclists. The first section leads through a dense forest high on a “well-maintained slope” (SG 1).

Here branches sporadically hang down to a height of 2.50 m. Once you have reached a hill (1350 m high), you can take a detour to a farm in summer and buy “Sir” (cheese).

From here you are outdoors! Panoramas par excellence. You can look down on the winding course of the slope. Shortly afterwards you can take a detour to the paragliding jump. The planes are driven up to the departure point in box vans.

From here the surface of the slope changes. It is a bit rockier (SG 2) but is (for us) the most beautiful section of the route due to the open views and the flowery vegetation.

Coming from the town of Zaga or from road 203, it is 5.2 km to Access.

Characteristic: after turning, you drive past a sign prohibiting motorcyclists and an open barrier. Shortly afterwards, the tarred road turns into a gravel track.
